



## *100% Capital allowance within 1st year for security equipment and installation*

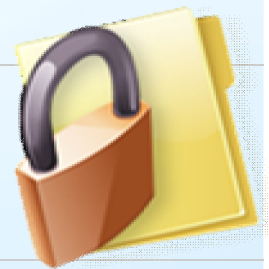
One of the highlights announced in Budget 2008 by our Prime Minister, Y Bhg Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi on 7 September 2007 - Tax Incentive given to companies - Accelerated Capital Allowance over a year will be given for the purchase of security and surveillance equipment to assist the private sector to enhance security at their sites, in particular at factory premises.

Besides, government had allocated RM 6bil to the police force under Budget 2008 to improve public safety. The force will be boosted with 60,000 new police personnel to be recruited over the next five years. The force will get 1,900 motorcycles, additional 2,000 cars and 1,600 laptops. More CCTV will be installed and linked to police control centre.



## *Security Policy*

In the course of carrying out security audits for many companies, we realized most do not have a SECURITY POLICY despite their high business high turnover, large employee base and 24 hours business operations. Their security risk ranges from low, medium to high depending very much on the attractiveness of their products and raw materials. However, we noticed they have Environmental Policy, Health & safety Policy and ISO 9001 Audit Policy but somehow SECURITY POLICY is absent.



Many of these companies suffered various degrees of internal losses (including external losses) but they are unable to control such losses due to the absence of a SECURITY POLICY.

A Security Policy is essential to define the various threats and counter measures taken to ensure potential losses is controlled and minimized. It assigned targets and responsibilities to the various departments and all losses must be reported and investigated thoroughly with actions taken and recommendations for further improvements.

Every employee must be familiar with the SECURITY POLICY and must comply with the rules set up by the organization.

It is also important to have a security assessment or audit to ensure the Security Policy is still relevant given the changes in the internal and external environment. Hence changes must be made to the policy to ensure its relevance and applications.

Organizations having a Security Policy and full compliance thereof are well managed and its profit enhanced due to zero/minimum losses suffered through internal and external threats. Once the organization has a strong security culture from the top to the bottom structure its expenses on security protection can be minimized.
