CCTV Digital Video Recorder

With the migration from analog to digital CCTV system many customers have installed either PC based or standalone DVR to record their CCTV. We have found many DVRs to be installed in wrong places – unsafe and easily sabotaged or removed or in a hot/humid and dusty environment. The time and date is also not synchronized and may cause a dispute in the event the recording is used for domestic inquiry, police investigation or court hearings. In the event there is more than 1 DVR installed at the customers place, all DVRs must be synchronized for the date/time settings. Other factors you have to consider includes recording frame per second (fps), motion activated recording, period of recording and external archiving.
