Contingency Plan—Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan for Influenza Flu**

The management of SECOM (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd has developed a Contingency Plan—Emergency Response Plan for Pandemic Influenza Flu to ensure the protection of employees and business continuity. This virus is efficiently transmitted from person to person and cause influenza outbreaks in many countries. We have developed an emergency preparedness for screening for influenza symptoms and perform a daily temperature check among all incoming personnel using INFRARED FOREHEAD THERMOMETER (non contact) at our guard house.
